

My Disappearing Bunny Rabbit, Trixie (Props: the four pieces of the bunny puzzle and your magic wand)

When you become a magician, it's actually a magical law that you must own a bunny rabbit that disappears. My parents won't let me have a real rabbit yet, so I have to use this one in the puzzle. She's my bunny Trixie. Everyone say "Hi" to Trixie, and give her a big round of applause. For Trixie's special magic trick, I'll need a volunteer as well. Jade, will you please help me to make Trixie disappear? What I want you to do is just make sure that these pieces are wooden, that they are painted, and that Trixie doesn't wipe off or anything like that. Is that true Jade? Everyone give Jade a big round of applause. Now what I'm going to do is pick up the four puzzle pieces, and...oh wait a minute, I forgot that I'll also need my magic wand. Okay as I wave the magic wand, everyone please help me say the magic words, "Bawanna Iguana". Everybody, "Bawanna Iguana." Very nice. Now, if we did it correctly, you'll see that when we put the puzzle pieces back together again...Trixie has somehow, mysteriously, disappeared. In fact, there isn't even a piece of wood, where Trixie was... Let's give Jade and yourselves a big round of applause for doing such a great job.

Quick order to remember:

- It's the law that a magician must own a disappearing bunny
- My parents won't let me have a real rabbit, so I have this one painted on this puzzle, her name is Trixie.
- Choose a helper to check if the pieces are really wood, if they are painted, and if Trixie wipes off or anything
- Pick up the four pieces, oops, I forgot that I also need my magic wand.
- Wave the wand and have everyone help you say "Bawanna Iguana"
- Put the pieces back together into a puzzle, and show that Trixie is gone
- In fact, the whole wooden piece is gone.
- Big round of applause for your helper and all the kids for helping.
